We welcome you to join us for our worship services. To finish the month of October we will only be having Sunday morning public services at 10:30. Sunday and Wednesday night services will only be available online as we continue to bounce back from an uptick in the COVID-19 virus in our church.

- We encourage everyone to perform a temperature check at home prior to attending a service. If elevated, stay home and watch us online.
- Any person who has had any contact with known COVID-19 confirmed cases or who has cold or flu symptoms or fever should stay home and self-quarantine for an appropriate time.
- High-risk individuals based on age or predisposed health conditions are advised not to attend.
- Face masks are optional, yet encouraged. We have them available upon request.
- Hand sanitizing and hand washing is urged.
- Ushers will assist with seating and dismissal, where possible.
- Multiple exits are available post services:
 - **Education wing** – on the west side.
 - **Carport** – on the south side.
 - **East side of sanctuary**
- Between each service our janitors will sanitize restrooms and all touching points utilized throughout our facility.
- Offering boxes are available at each exit.
- A nursery will be available for mothers with children. No nursery care will be provided.

The following details will be in place until changes can be made.

- For our services, when the sanctuary, annexes and foyers are filled according to social distancing, the overflow will be directed to the Family Life Center to watch the service by livestream.
- We will continue the children's segment in the Sunday morning services.
- Sunday morning services will be at 10:30 AM.
- Sunday night services will be at 6:30 PM - online only until November 1st.
- A Wednesday night Sunday school lesson will be at 7:30 PM - online only until November 1st.

We recognize there are strong feelings on every side of this pandemic issue, therefore some will not feel comfortable to participate in a public church service just yet. Others are begging for the opportunity to worship together. Let us all be gracious toward one another's preferences. There should be no condemnation offered by any. Let us trust the Lord to help us all as we navigate our way through the impact of the coronavirus.
